## Kazakhstan Accedes to the 2007 Hague Convention



On 6 June 2017, the Republic of Kazakhstan deposited its instrument of accession to the Hague Convention of 23 November 2007 on the International Recovery of Child Support and Other Forms of Family Maintenance (2007 Child Support Convention). With Kazakhstan's accession,

there are now 36 States and one Regional Economic Integration Organisation that have either signed, ratified or acceded to the 2007 Child Support Convention.

Kazakhstan, which has also recently become a Member of the HCCH, is now a Contracting State to a total of eight Hague Conventions and a Protocol.









## Brazil Signs and Ratifies the 2007 Hague Child Support Convention and 2007 Hague Maintenance Protocol

On 17 July 2017, Brazil signed and deposited the instruments of ratification of the

Hague Convention of 23 November 2007 on the International Recovery of Child Support and Other Forms of Family Maintenance (2007 Child Support Convention) and the Hague Protocol of 23 November 2007 on the Law Applicable to Maintenance Obligations (2007 Maintenance Protocol). The Convention and the Protocol will enter into force for Brazil on 1 November 2017.
